Senior Counselor at beginning of Second Session, A.D. rest of Second and beginning of Third.

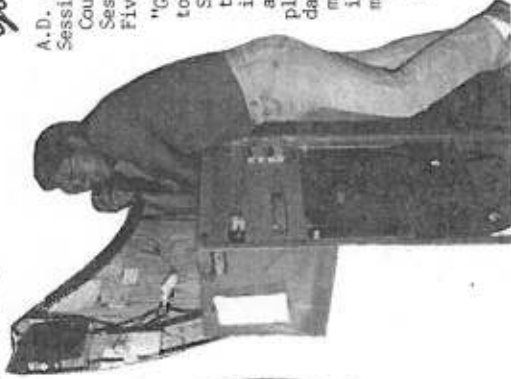

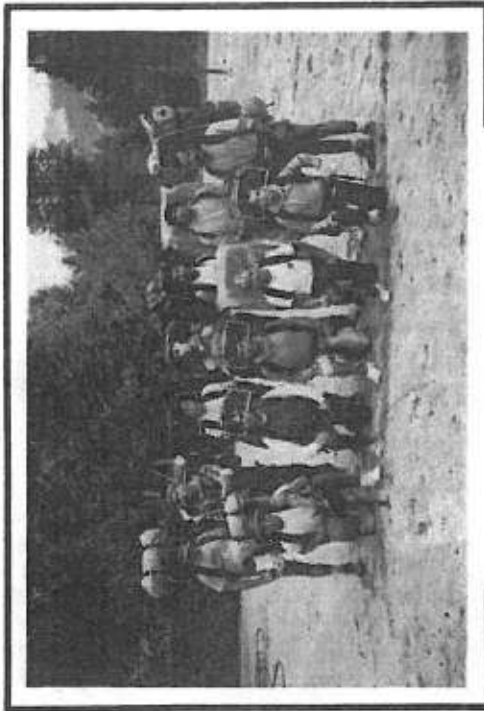

Pyles Leadership Training is a program that began in 1982 as a means of providing more in-depth counselor training than the Lion Meadows program alone provides. "Candidates" for this special session are chosen by the Camp Manager, Assistant Directors, and Lion Meadows Directors. Those chosen are people who have shown the potential to become really excellent counselors, either from their progress as workers at the Camp, or in some cases their actual counseling experiences.

Two "veteran" Pyles Counselors (who have gone on to be Senior Counselors, Assistant Directors, and so on) conduct this unique training experience, which took place this year during Fourth Session, in Lion Meadows. This year's "pros" were Eddy "Chain" Cadena and Allen "Big Al" Shelby, with combined Pyles Camp experiences of more than thirty years.

Like other training sessions at Pyles, this included an Outcamp. This year's group made a big loop; from Pyles to Lion to Trout Meadows to Upper Camp to Lower Camp to Kern Camp, back into the main Camp to re-stock (Lucky left at this point and Cobra joined the crew), then to Gray Meadow to Bear Camp and finally back to Lion Meadows. The underlying theme of the program this year was T.E.A.M. = Together Everyone Achieves More. It was a learning experience for all concerned, for as Chain says, "I've been with Pyles Camp for twenty years, and I learn something every time I come here. We never know everything, and therefore we should never stop trying to learn".

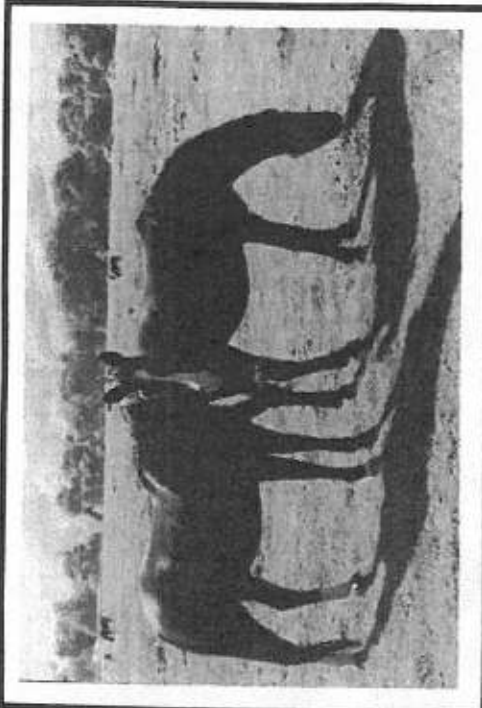
