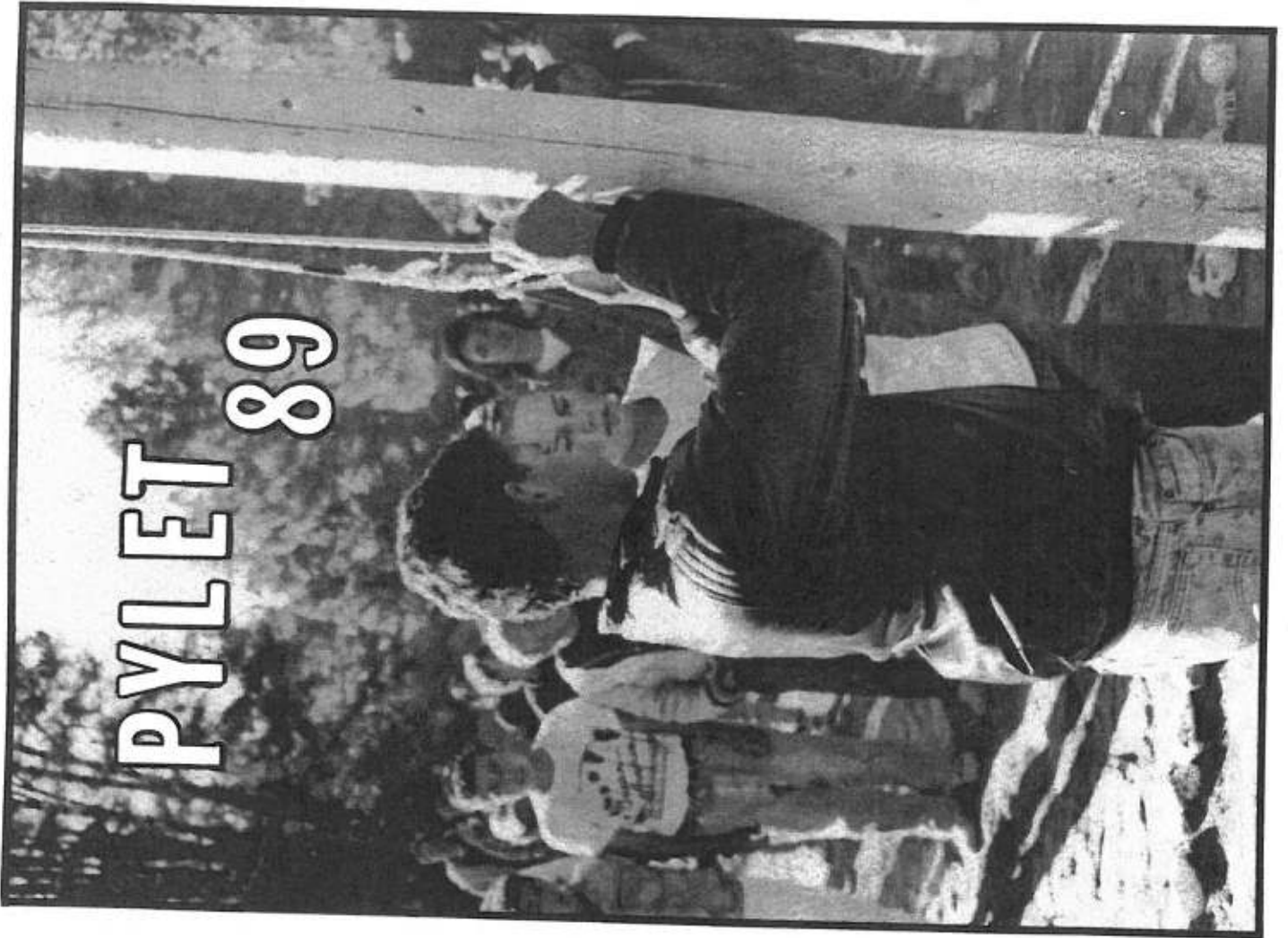


PYLET 89

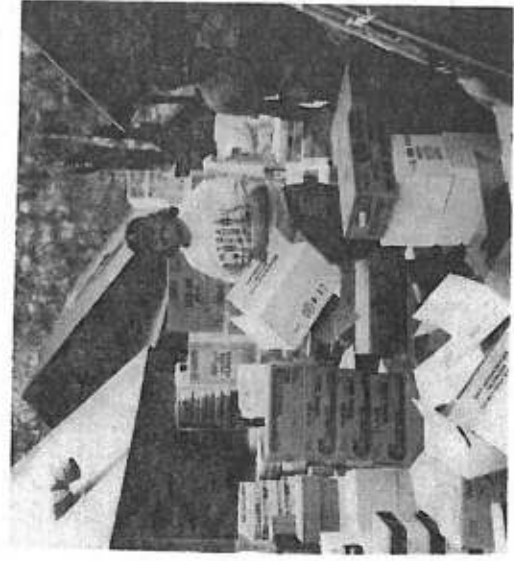
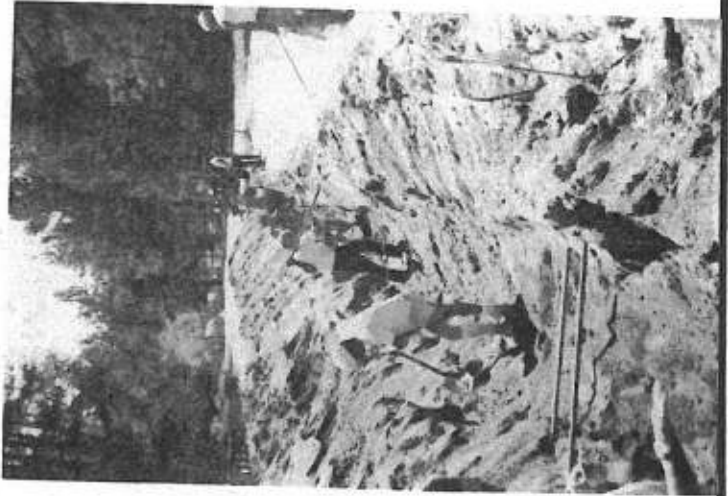
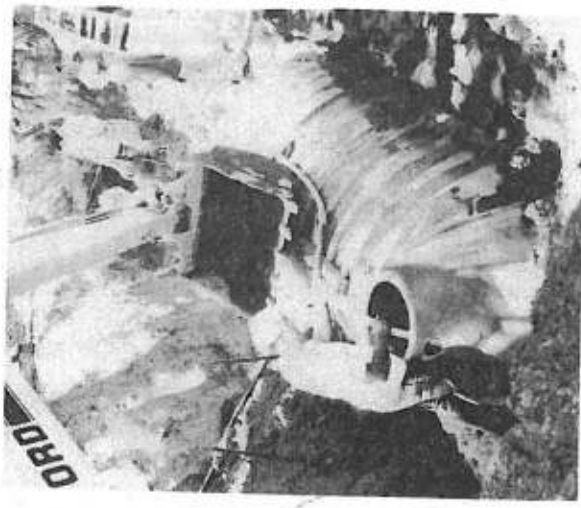
CAMP OPENING and...

So, if you liked the Main Camp, you will love Lion Meadows.



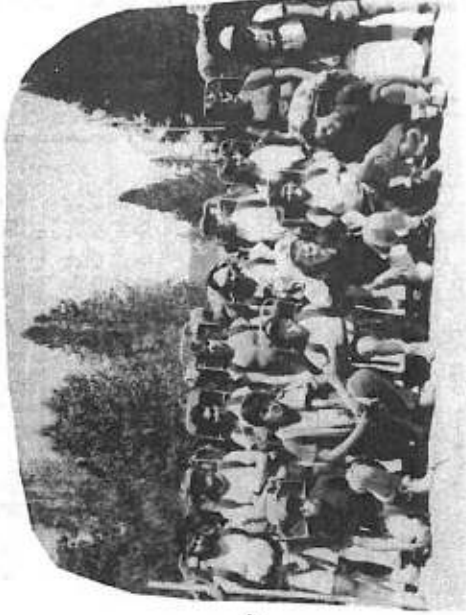

O'Riley was the main instructor with expert help from Tango and Rubi.

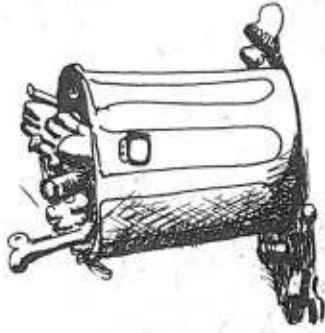


Touche shows off his cooking talents at the counselor training session in May.

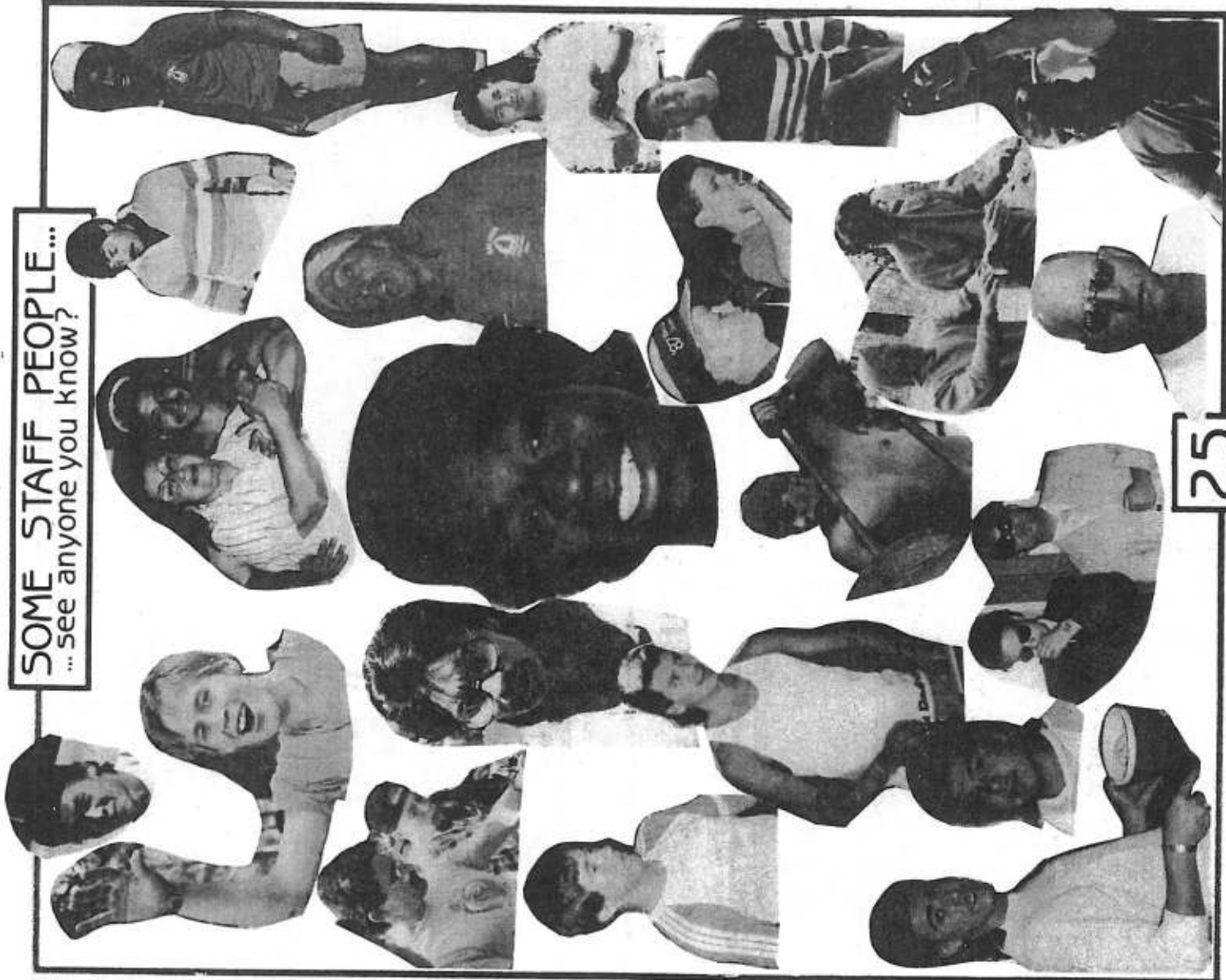
