This Years Pylet is Dedicated to Orange Belt Stages

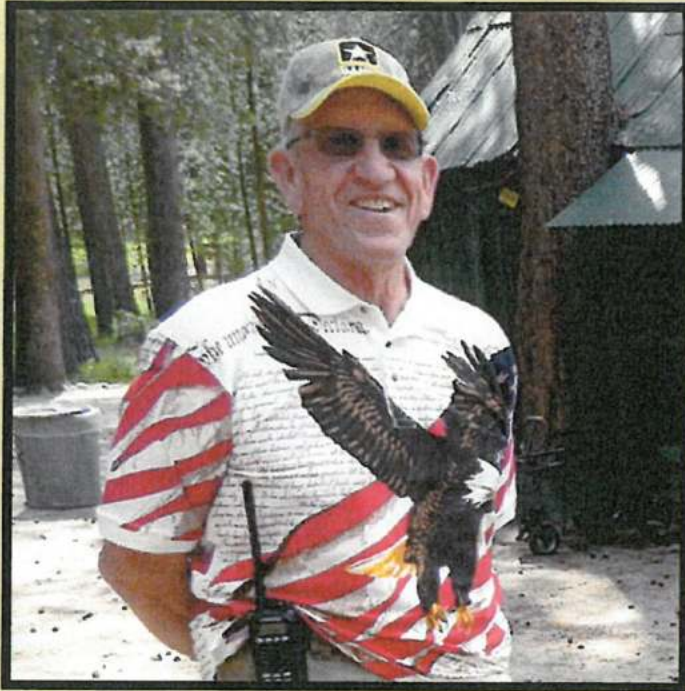

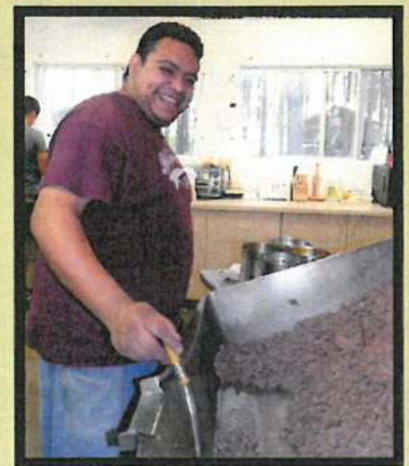
Special Recognition To Our Cooks
